# Stravifloor Mat-F

### Installation Manual



#### Installation Tools and Components

- Stanley knife
- Personal protective equipment (PPE)

#### 1 / Underscreed Layer

Unpack and unroll the Stravifloor Mat-F and allow it to acclimatize for 24 hours in the intended installation area.

Stravifloor Mat-F can be loose laid without the use of mechanical fixings or adhesive. In order to decouple the walls from the floating floor ensure the Stravifloor Mat-F is also installed onto the walls - the distance up the wall should be the same as the intended thickness of the screed/concrete to be poured.

#### 2 / Protection Layer

A protective layer of building grade polythene should be loose laid over the Stravifloor Mat-F and continued up the wall to cover the Perimeter Strip. Allow overlaps of 100 mm.


## Or Taped Joints


If a protective layer of polythene is not installed the joints of the Stravifloor Mat-F should be taped together with building grade self-adhesive tape (minimum 50 mm wide).



Recommended Duct Tapes:

#### 3 / Screed or Reinforced Concrete Slab

Install the screed or reinforced concrete to the required height.

If a skirting board is required leave a gap of 3 mm so there is no rigid contact between the skirting board and the new floating floor.
