Installation Tools and Components

- Ink marker
- Pocket tape measure
- Clean cloth
- Personal protective equipment (PPE)

1 / Supporting Floor & System Components

Ensure the CLT-modules are physically sound, clean and dry prior to installation.

Mark where the Straviwood ModuBreak bearings will be installed.

2 / Install Straviwood ModuBreak Bearings

Apply a thin layer of glue and place the Straviwood ModuBreak bearings on top. Press firmly in order to reduce the thickness of the glue to a minimum. Remove any access glue coming out from under the pads with a clean cloth.

Recommended Glue

- Rectavit S40 Flex MS Polymer
- Rectavit 1128 EPDM Spray
- Rectavit 1129 Fat Forward
- Rectavit G60 Pro Heavy Duty

3 / Install The Second Module

Once the Straviwood ModuBreak bearings are installed and the glue has set, the second CLT-module can be placed on top of the Straviwood ModuBreak bearings. Be careful not to damage the bearings while installing the second module.
